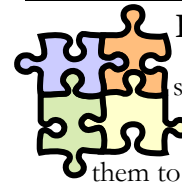

is a new tool to help freshman students transition into the high school ministry at Lutheran Church of the Master and equip them to live out their faith after

Confirmation. This ministry lasts through Confirmation Sunday on Reformation Sunday - Oct. 30, 2011. Confirmation service for all ninth-grade LCM students, both campuses, will be at 2:30 p.m. Oct. 30 at the West Campus. Next year, the service will be at the East Campus.

Families will learn the facets of Freshman Connect:

1. **Appreciative Coaching:** Through Gallup's Strengthfinder survey, students and parents will learn about individual talents and strengths and how each student can contribute theirs to the Kingdom of God. Parents are encouraged to take their own survey. Coaching sessions will be East and West Sept. 28 and Oct. 2.
2. **Xcell ministries:** LCM high school ministry that includes Sunday School and Cell Groups, beginning Sept. 18; A Wednesday night cell began Sept. 7.
3. **One-on-one mentoring:** a loving adult from LCM who will spend intentional time with an assigned student, walking alongside his or her family in care. This will be an ongoing ministry past Confirmation Sunday.
