EL SALVADOR MISSION TRIP JUNE 23 - JULY 1

A mission trip to El Salvador by Lutheran Church of the Master students, grade 9 - 12, is planned for June 23 - July 1.

The \$500 cost represents a \$1,000 discount, but it requires participation in two mandatory fundraisers, the Feb. 12 Chili/Soup Cook-off and a May 6 golf scramble at Pacific Springs Golf Course.

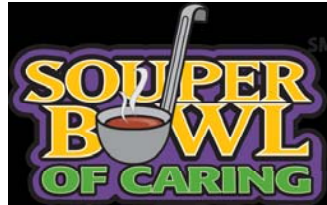
