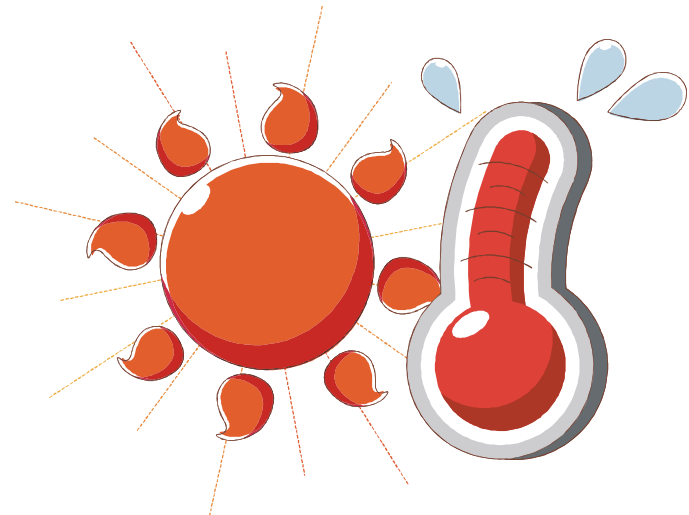

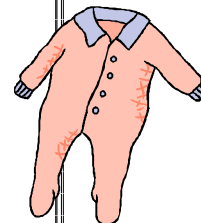

Diapers: newborn & sizes 4, 5

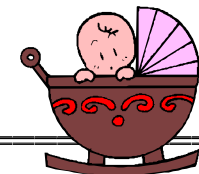
Bibs, socks, onesies - all sizes

Seven - eight families are interested in vegetable
gardening, 1 - 2 plots each. They plan 12 - 15 plots,
5 X10 feet, at about \$20 apiece. Rich Tiller was looking
into getting a dump truck to haul compost from
Omagro, Bellevue; Vicki Melies has a tiller to lend;
Ernie Steel, a master gardener, has found some
chicken wire.

"Hopefully we'll have the ground disked, then add
Omagro and rototill it in," Jayne Dean, coordinator,
said. "Then we'll stake out the plots, work on the
pathways between the plots and start planting.
Ernie Steel will give advice and help as needed.

"Things are falling into place and with God's help,
we'll get this mission accomplished this
spring."
