If you would like to attend, fill out the registration form above and drop it in the designated box at the Welcome Center at either campus.

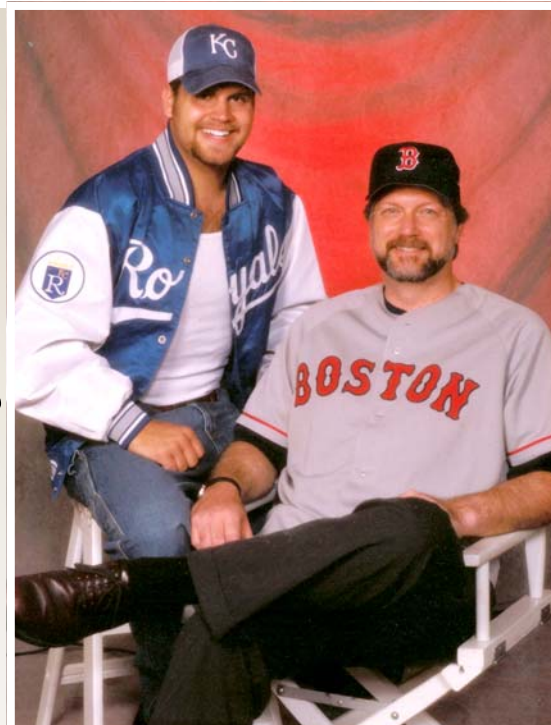
